# ETERNITY IN MY HEART FASTING FORWARD

I KINGS 21:1-28 (NASV)

#### I. WHAT LENT IS

**DEFINITION:** Lent comes from the Anglo Saxon word for spring.

**INSIGHT:** Lent is a time to turn away from something, to deprive yourself of something, to draw closer to God and fast forward your life for life change.

**INSIGHT:** Repentance is about turning away from something that takes you away from God.

**INSIGHT:** At the end of Lent you celebrate God's grace and forgiveness with an Easter feast of food.

#### II. BIBLICAL FASTING

**INSIGHT:** Biblical fasting is abstaining, usually from food, for the purpose of drawing near to God to invoke His help and blessing on our lives and impossible life situations.

# **IMPORTANT FASTING FACTS:**

- 1. You know the specific reason you are fasting.
- 2. The fast you choose really hits your normal life, making it impossible to forget during the day.
- 3. Every day you will remember you are turning away from something to turn toward God.
- 4. Every day your fast will remind you to pray about something specific.
- 5. Every day your fast will remind you to think about how you are tracking with God.

# III. THE LOST KING WHO TOUCHED GOD'S HEART

**INSIGHT:** King Ahab committed what the Bible calls the sin unto death (*I John 5:16*).

There are two types:

- 1. For believers, I Corinthians 5:5
- 2. For hardened lost sinners, I Kings 21:19

**INSIGHT:** God responded to the fasting and humility by a lost man condemned to destruction!

# IV. THE BLESSING TRIO

**INSIGHT:** Fasting is a source of power that most Christians don't know about.

**INSIGHT:** Jesus gave three specific duties for every Christian in His Sermon on the Mount: giving, praying, and fasting.

**INVITATION TO COMMIT:** I want us to leave today with the three motivations for fasting that should move any thinking Christian to commit to **THE FORTY DAY LENT FAST:** 

- 1. You set the course for the rest of the year. Giving God the first of your year through fasting secures His blessings for the next ten months.
- 2. Blessings will happen for you and your family throughout the year because you fasted now.
- 3. When we fast, the Matthew 6:33 principle is put in play: "Seek first the kingdom of God...and all these things will be added to you." Seeking Him first brings all "these things" to your life the rest of the year.
