### I CORINTHIANS 13:1 (NASB)

**TRUTH:** The prayers of many spouses go unanswered because they fail at love.

**INSIGHT:** Nothing hinders prayers for family like lack of love (I Peter 3:1, 7 LB).

## I. THE VALUE OF LANGUAGE

**TRUTH:** Language is the foundation on which relationships are built and maintained. Proverbs 18:21 (Msg), 10:11 (Msg), 12:18 (NLT), 15:1 (NLT), 15:4 (Msg), 16:24 (NLT); Ephesians 4:29 (NLT)

**TRUTH:** Every spouse needs to hear these love languages from their spouse, but each spouse hears love differently.

**INSIGHT:** Your love language and your spouse's can be as different as English and Russian.

**TRUTH:** God's long awaited answer to your prayers for your spouse may be answered by this message.
