JONAH 4:1-11 (NASB)

Four chapters in Jonah and you and I are in one of them:

- 1. Chapter One: Running from God
 - a) Discipline (Hebrews 12:6, 8)
 - b) Danger
- 2. Chapter Two: Running to God
- 3. Chapter Three: Running with God
- 4. Chapter Four: Running ahead of God

I. FOR ME BUT NOT OTHERS

INSIGHT: Jonah ran from God's call because of the good he feared God would do for people he didn't want God to save.

INSIGHT: Spiritual narcissism is rampant in churches across America.

DEFINITION: Narcissism is the preoccupation with self (Matthew 9:12-13 Msg).

OUR DNA: By the grace of God nothing on "The Hill" will be shoddy, second rate, or shallow... because every Sunday matters!

II. THE HEART OF GOD (Jonah 4:11)

INSIGHT: The final lesson of life change is having your heart break for the things that break God's heart.

INVITATION: I want to invite you to a time of prayer:

- *Do you care about this city?
- *Do you live like people can just go to hell?
- *Are you the one God's heart is breaking for?
- *Do you need to pray the prayer of salvation?
- *Do you need to pray about God's call you never answered?
- *Do you need to pray about swallowing pride and admit a Jonah life?
- *Do you need to pray about returning to a love for lost souls?
