## 1 CORINTHIANS 13:4-7 (NASB)

**REALITY:** Romance gets challenging as time passes.

How do we keep the fire of romance burning in marriage?

#### I. COMPLETE THE JOURNEY OF ROMANCE.

Five relational stages of romance that lead to marriage:

- 1. Attraction
- 2. Disappointment

**TRUTH:** Disappointment reveals reality, and if profound enough it can and should end the relationship.

**REALITY:** Many end their marriage because of disappointment.

**TRUTH:** Disappointment happens in every marriage and has to be worked through.

3. Acceptance

**TRUTH:** Acceptance is a foundation stone of any lasting marriage.

- 4. Appreciation
- 5. Relational intimacy

### II. ACTION TRUMPS FEELINGS IN MARRIAGE.

**TRUTH:** Disappointment pours water on the fire of romance so you can't feel the heat of love.

- 1. Feelings >>> Actions: this is how people think life works.
- 2. Actions >>>Feelings: this is reality.

**TRUTH:** Meaningful marriage comes from actions not feelings.

**REALITY:** Every marriage is hard work, 24/7, demanding investment of time, energy and resources.

- 3. Romance → Reality → Actions → Feelings
- 4. Romance → Reality → Feelings → Death

# III. GO FOR LOVE (1 Corinthians 13:4-7 NIV).

Elements of marital love:

- 1. You choose to trust them.
- 2. You choose to have hope in them.
- 3. You choose to persevere.
- 4. The one thing you can't have if the marriage lasts: an exit sign over the door.
