## John Greene, Senior Pastor "HIS NAME IS JESUS"

**LUKE 1:26-32 (NASB)** 

**TRUTH:** The name that the baby of Bethlehem, the Savior of the world, is best known by is Jesus.

## I. "JESUS" IS A HUMBLE NAME.

**INSIGHT:** Jesus' earthly pedigree was partly why the Bible says the common people heard Him gladly.

Two thoughts on the name "Jesus":

A. It's a name of majesty.

**TRUTH:** The Bible says that no man can go up to bring heaven down, but heaven can come down to bring any man up.

B. It's a name of mystery.

**TRUTH:** Mary became an earthly mother without the help of an earthly father, and Jesus had a heavenly Father but no heavenly mother.

**INSIGHT:** We don't have to understand the virgin birth to believe it.

## II. "JESUS" IS A SAVING NAME.

**INSIGHT:** "Jesus" in the Greek, also "Joshua" in Hebrew, means: *The Lord Is Salvation* or *God saves*.

**TRUTH:** All the problems of humanity stem from one source: our sins!

**TRUTH:** The message of Christmas is that all of us are sinners in need of a Savior.

**TRUTH:** If you don't connect the cross of Calvary to the cradle of Christmas, you miss God's message to you at Christmas.
