SERIES STATEMENT: The World Is Changing, May God's People Emerge with Purpose

INSIGHT: People are currently experiencing social, emotional, and spiritual drought.

PRINCIPLES FOR EMERGING FROM DROUGHT:

1) Reflect on God's previous provision (1 Kings 17:1-24).

ACTION POINT: At lunch today, discuss the areas of drought and how God has provided flour and oil to help you get through.

2) Recalibrate your priorities (1 Kings 18:20-41).

TRUTH: One positive of a drought is we are forced to confront the reality of what we believe to be true.

TRUTH: Either you will make your schedule or someone else will.

ACTION POINT: Give time this week to determining the priorities that will shape your schedules.

3) Anticipate challenges (1 Kings 19:1-18).

TRUTH: Convincing ourselves that we are alone is the quickest path to defeat and despair.

4) Do the next right thing (1 Kings 19:19-21).

ACTION POINT: This week make a commitment to reconnect with worship, the mission, and the remnant.
