"KNOWING YOU'RE SAVED"

JOHN 2:23-3:16

CORE STATEMENT: The Bible commands that as a follower of Jesus Christ YOU invest in others what Jesus and others have invested in YOU.

DEFINITION: Replication means reproducing the teaching and the life of Jesus Christ in others.

TRUTH: Replication, reproducing the life of Christ in you in another, is the heart of the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20).

Our goal for the next three weeks:

- 1. What to say in leading someone to Christ. What's salvation about? How can you know for sure you are saved?
- 2. How to talk to them about the importance of the Bible in their daily life.
- 3. How do you begin a life of prayer?

INSIGHT: The basics of the faith are foundational to a changed life.

FACTOID: 67% of Americans say they have a relationship with Christ; 50% say they've prayed a prayer asking Jesus into their heart, yet 50% of them have no regular presence in any kind of church, and 2/3 have lifestyles and worldviews that do not differ from those outside the Christian faith (John 2:24).

I. WHY YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN (Romans 3:23; Psalm 51:5; Genesis 2:17)

INSIGHT: Original sin means we are born with sick hearts, minds and wills. We don't love what we should, and we love what we shouldn't.

TRUTH: Sin has killed us...we are dead to God, and we need something outside us to come in and change us at our core (John 3:5; Ezekiel 36:25-27, 37:1-9).

TRUTH: Ezekiel 37:9 is the work of God in the church, and this is what you need.

INSIGHT: God doesn't want to change your behavior; He wants to change your desires!

II. HOW YOU CAN BE BORN AGAIN (John 3:14; Numbers 21:6)

INSIGHT: Serpents were the result of their sin; death and hell is the result of ours (John 3:16).

TRUTH: Belief without full surrender is demonic faith.
