

## "CELEBRATION: GOD'S PRODIGAL LOVE" John Greene, Senior Pastor

LUKE 15:11-32 (NASB)

**INSIGHT:** People want to divorce the moral teaching of Jesus from His supernatural life, specifically His resurrection from the dead.

**INSIGHT:** If you don't believe in the resurrection, don't read 1 Corinthians 13 at your wedding.

**TRUTH:** Everything you appreciate about Jesus came from people who believed that He rose from the dead and who said if the resurrection is a lie, so is everything else.

**CAVEAT:** The 25<sup>th</sup> of this month we're planning a baptism Sunday, offering to baptize at each service.

Possible issues to reject our offer:

- 1. Why should I get wet publicly?
- 2. Baptism is supposed to happen after a personal decision to trust and follow Christ.
- 3. If you were baptized as an infant, that was a good thing but see it for what it was: it represented the faith of your parents.

A couple of corrections to the story of the prodigal son:

- 1. The main character isn't the runaway son...it's the Father.
- 2. "Prodigal" doesn't mean runaway. The dictionary meaning is reckless, wasteful. A prodigal is someone who spends till there's nothing left.

**INSIGHT:** "Prodigal" is more about the father because the heart of the story is his reckless love for a wayward son.

**INSIGHT:** The youngest wanted his dad's money but not his dad (v. 11).

**INSIGHT:** Not wanting God in our lives is a picture of sin.

**INSIGHT:** Sin isn't just immoral acts, but at its core, it's the desire to be free of God.

I. GOD LOVES YOU EVEN WHEN YOU REJECT HIM AND BREAK HIS HEART (vv. 11-12).

## II. SIN IS FUN FOR A WHILE BUT ALWAYS BRINGS PAIN (vv. 13-16).

**INSIGHT:** The winds of blessing always change when we run from God.

**INSIGHT:** Sin usually starts great, but the trajectory is to pain and loss.

**TRUTH:** God has a love for you even while you are running away from Him.

## III. GOD LOVES YOU AS HE BRINGS YOU BACK (vv. 17-20).

**TRUTH:** No prodigal ever comes home that the Father wasn't drawing him.

**INSIGHT:** You don't see it illustrated as much in the other two stories, but the point declared in story #3 is that it's the Father who is seeking that which is lost.

**TRUTH:** God arranges the circumstances of our lives to draw us to Himself.

## IV. YOU CAN CHOOSE TO STAY OUTSIDE OF GOD'S LOVE FOREVER (v. 28).

**INSIGHT:** The religious person who has lived a good life thinks God owes them but has never experienced God's grace and has no relationship with God.

**TRUTH:** The older brother is near his father's house, but he doesn't have his father's heart.

**TRUTH:** Religion cleans you up on the outside without changing you on the inside.
